

Downtown Chillicothe, First Capital Enterprises and The Pioneer Center are trying to make our downtown more handicap friendly, and by doing so we are posing 2 questions...

- 1. Could your downtown business use a portable handicap ramp? Years ago, we received grant money to purchase 17 portable ramps and we provided them to businesses with large flagstone entry steps. We would like to write another grant for additional ramps if the need is out there. Would this benefit you?
- 2. Would you be willing to have Capital City Crusaders (individuals with intellectual and physical disabilities), visit your business to see if your business is handicap inclusive and easily maneuverable for individuals with physical limitations? An example would be, could a person in a wheelchair come into your restaurant and easily order a meal, choose a table, and navigate within your business. If you meet the needs of the Capital City Crusaders, you could receive a handicap inclusivity endorsement from The Pioneer Center!

Do not confuse this with handicap accessibility, we simply want to see if handicapped individuals can get around easily in your place of business. If you are interested in taking part in either one, or both, please let us know and we will work to make the ramp and the visit a reality.


