# DOWNTOWN BUSINESS SPOTLIGHT: PAPER CITY COFFEE/ THE PAGE

★ Spotlight on Paper City Coffee & The Page: A Downtown Gem with a Heart for Community ★

Downtown Chillicothe is home to many beloved small businesses, and Paper City Coffee has long been one of its brightest stars. This year, PCC celebrated nine years in business—nearly a decade of serving not only excellent coffee but also meaningful community impact.

If you've ever stepped inside, you know PCC isn't just a coffee shop. It's a gathering place, a home for regulars, a haven for newcomers, and a staple of our downtown experience—and yes, the cinnamon rolls are absolutely legendary.

Nearly two years ago, the Harper Family purchased the business, stepping into ownership with enthusiasm, vision, and deep personal ties to PCC. Having served as staff members, mentors, and creators behind some of the shop's iconic spaces, they already carried the heart of PCC with them. Today, they continue the original mission: supporting teens in our region through the Paper City Mentoring Project, while keeping the shop a place where everyone feels welcome.

This year, PCC refreshed its menu with heartier breakfast and lunch offerings, including new fan favorites like the Breakfast Burrito with house-made salsa and the vibrant, filling PCC Grain Bowl. Handmade syrups, scratch-made dishes, and their brand-new in-house coffee roasting program make each visit feel extra special.

But the story doesn't end when the coffee shop closes. From Wednesday through Saturday afternoons, PCC transforms into The Page, an upscale cocktail bar now entering its third year. With craft cocktails, curated wine and beer, non-alcoholic drinks that never compromise on quality, and cozy no-pressure vibes, The Page has become a key part of downtown's nightlife. Their top seller—the Boomer, a silky espresso martini—shows off just how seamlessly they bridge the coffee-and-cocktail worlds.

The Page has also grown into a true community hub—not just through its events like cocktail classes, puzzle competitions, bingo, and trivia, but through its vibrant live music scene. In fact, music has become one of their biggest draws. The Page is now recognized as one of downtown's top spots for live performances, offering music almost every weekend and hosting a beloved Jazz Night on the second Thursday of each month. And yes—mocktail lovers are welcome. Their team takes just as much care crafting non-alcoholic offerings as they do their signature cocktails.

What makes PCC and The Page truly unique is their combination of craft, creativity, and care. Nestled in a historic downtown building full of character, their atmosphere is shaped not only by the space itself but by the dedicated staff and loyal customers who fill it. From house-made syrups to experimenting with new flavors to carrying locally made, all-natural candles, the team pours intention into every detail.

When asked what they love most about being downtown, the answer comes easily: the people—regulars, visitors, neighbors, and fellow business owners who make Chillicothe special.

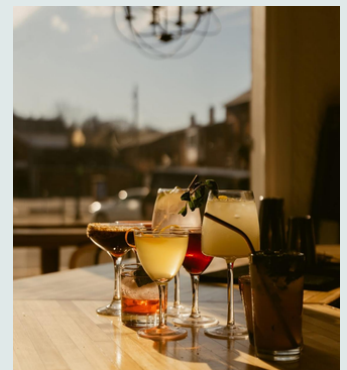
Their community involvement runs deep as well. Though their roots are in supporting the Paper City Mentoring Project, PCC also partners with additional youth-centered programs across the area, believing strongly that investing in young people builds the foundation for long-term change.

And if you think you know everything about PCC, think again—they now roast their own coffee, and both PCC and The Page offer rental opportunities for private events, showers, and celebrations.

Customer favorites? At PCC, the Maple Bourbon Latte, Sweet Caramel Latte, and hearty Breakfast BLT top the charts. Over at The Page, the Ok, Boomer, the classic Old Fashioned, and the playful Lazy Susan (featuring rotating house-made syrup) keep guests coming back.

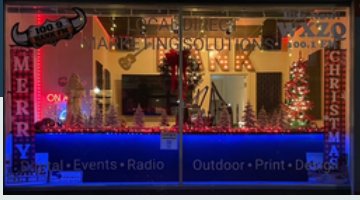
Holiday Reminder: DORA Is In Season! 🍷🎄

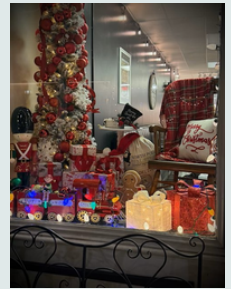
